DeSousa and Tremblay not on same page

Re: City unveils greenhouse gas plan (The Suburban, March 14). In the article, executive committee member Alan DeSousa gave examples of how greenhouse gases can be reduced by 20 percent in the next five years. One example was that city workers would be encouraged to “save energy by turning off lights, heating and air conditioning...”

DeSousa also said, “Before the city can ask others to make an effort, the city has to make sure that its own house is making an effort.”

Yet, in an article in the Gazette, March 7, relating to Mayor Tremblay’s plans for the “entertainment district” in downtown Montreal, Tremblay said the proposals include the plan “to light up the outside of buildings...”
