I too have been analyzing the details of the Deux-Montagnes train schedule and I can say for a fact that all arriving trains until and including the 08:30 arrival are sent back for other runs, either in service or as "deadheads" (which are empty trains that don't carry and passengers and thus don't appear on the schedule). To prove this, take a look at the train numbers. You'll notice the first three heading towards Deux-Montagnes are numbered 913, 917 and 921. That means that there's a 911, 915 and 919 trains that don't carry and passengers and become three extra departures from Deux-Montagnes.
